#### The Brotherhood

The brotherhood is a father support network that connects program fathers with other local dads who serve as a mentor. These fatherhood mentors are there to provide support when it is needed, and even when support resources and to other parents in their it is not. Mentors can help program fathers set goals, offer another perspective, and share a few laughs. Connections happen via phone, text, or email.
